PERRYSBURG, OH. – With the threat of severe weather still facing many states in the east, the clean-up continues for the thousands of victims left in the path of this latest outbreak of thunderstorms and tornadoes that has swept the country. Throughout the month of April alone, the National Weather Service has preliminary reports of 654 tornadoes that have affected hundreds of thousands of people across the United States.
